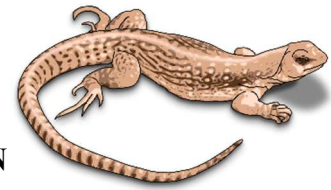


## GIST Field Trip: Reptile Dissections at CSUN
